MAIN MESSAGE:

LESSON:

I know it probably wasn't made for hammering, but it works pretty well in certain situations!

There are a lot of things in the world today that Satan is trying to use to get to each one of us and our families. It could and can be things like stress, not only from work, but even from our families like our relationship with our spouse or our children, or the stress of being so busy with everything that is going on with our children's sports, recital's, band, boy scouts, etc.... It might even be the stress of money! Oh how we hate stressing about money!

What we have to realize is that even though things may seem bad sometimes, and they may even seem like there is no way to get out, there is someone that is watching over you. He is wanting to see us make the decisions in our lives that will reflect Him!
