**SONG:** "Living By Faith"

## MAIN MESSAGE:

Seeing the faith of other Christians, like parents and grandparents, is a valuable way to learn what it means to live every day for God. But we are not always around these other Christian examples, so we have to develop a faith of our own that stretches beyond our home.

## LESSON:

Almost everyone has an extension cord nearby because of how useful they are to stretch the power that comes from an electrical outlet to other places far away from it. There is another power source that we can tap into that can be stretched all the way around the world. This is power that only comes from God.

One of the most exciting times of my life was when I got to leave home and go to college. I was on my own. I could make my own decisions. You would think all of that freedom and independence would be exciting, but it turned out to be a little bit frightening.
